The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the 2023 Annual Certification dated December 5, 2023, and the Final Groundwater Report dated September 2023 for the above referenced site. After completing our review of the referenced documents, EPD concurs with the findings of the Final Groundwater Report that the POD and POE groundwater monitoring locations meet the established residential risk-based standards for 1,2-dibromoethane (EDB) and the scheduled groundwater monitoring events can cease. The groundwater monitoring requirements established within the Uniform Environmental Covenant and associated Monitoring and Maintenance Plan have been met and the monitoring wells at the site may be closed in compliance with the Georgia Water Well Standards Act, O.C.G.A §12-5-134, and Section 2.8 "Well Decommissioning (Abandonment)" of Guidance for the Design and Installation of Monitoring Wells, which can be found at http://www.epa.gov/region4/sesd/fbqstp/Design-and-Installation-of-Monitoring-Wells.pdf.
