NOTICE OF INTENT TO RENEW PERMIT

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, under the authority of the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-8-60, et seq., as amended, announces its intent to renew Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Number HW-036(D)-3 issued to Delta Air Lines, Incorporated (Delta) for corrective action for releases of hazardous constituents from historical operations at the facility and post-closure care of a closed UST. Delta is located at 1775 M.H. Jackson Service Road, Atlanta, Georgia 30354 having the assigned facility EPA I.D. No. GAD006924872.

Delta operates an aircraft maintenance and repair facility at the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport in the City of Atlanta, Georgia. The Technical Operations Center conducts overhaul, service, and repairs of aircraft. Hazardous waste is generated from degreasing, painting, paint stripping, engine cleaning, and electroplating processes conducted at the facility.

The draft permit will include post-closure care requirements for a closed UST that will be treated as a landfill unit; and corrective action activities for SWMUs identified at the site. The facility will operate a less than 90-day storage area for storing hazardous waste generated at the site. **THIS PERMIT RENEWAL DOES NOT AUTHORIZE ANY ADDITIONAL DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS WASTE AT THE FACILITY.**

The State of Georgia received final authorization for the 1984 amendments to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), as amended, on September 18, 1986. Therefore, upon renewal, the permit will constitute a full RCRA permit as required by the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act and RCRA.

The draft permit has been prepared in accordance with the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-11. Before making its final decision to renew the permit, Section 391-3-11-.01 (40 CFR 124.10) of the Rules requires EPD to provide an opportunity for public comment. Accordingly, a public comment period has been arranged from July 6, 2023, to August 22, 2023. During the public comment period, a copy of the draft permit renewal and supporting documents will be available for public review at the following locations during regular business hours:
