

PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, under the authority of the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-8-60, et. seq., as amended, announces its intent to modify Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. HW-020(S&T) issued to Perma-Fix of South Georgia, Inc. (PFSG) located in Valdosta, Georgia. If modified, the permit will reinstate treatment and storage of hazardous waste on the property, continue to require post-closure care at regulated units that were unable to achieve clean-closure, and conduct investigation and corrective action to remediate releases of hazardous constituents into the environment.

PFSG owns and previously operated a hazardous waste treatment and storage facility located at 1612 James P. Rodgers Circle, Valdosta, Georgia. Hazardous waste formerly managed at the facility included industrial chemical products such as ignitable and chlorinated solvents, volatile organic compounds, and semi-volatile organic compounds; some of which were released to the environment. Following a facility fire in 2013, PFSG decided to stop storing and treating hazardous waste. The facility failed to demonstrate clean-closure of the permitted tank and container units and was required to submit a permit application for post-closure care of the regulated units. PFSG was issued a renewal Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. HW-020(D) on February 11, 2020 for post-closure care for the Hazardous Waste Management Units (HWMUs), groundwater monitoring and corrective action for the HWMUs, and corrective action for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and other releases. On February 13, 2023, the permit was updated to incorporate the Post-Closure Care Plan (PCCP) and the changes made by the Director to the groundwater protection standards (GWPS) applicable to the facility. This modified permit, if approved, will allow PFSG to resume treatment and storage of hazardous waste on the property, continue to require post-closure care at regulated units and continue to require the permittee to conduct investigation and corrective action to remediate releases of hazardous constituents into the environment.

A draft modified permit has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-11. The draft permit does **not** allow for disposal of hazardous waste on-site.

Before making its final decision on whether to issue the modified permit, state and federal regulations require that the EPD provide an opportunity for public comment. Accordingly, a public comment period has been arranged for **July 9, 2026 through August 24, 2026**. The applicant and those persons who submit written comments or request notice of the final permit decision will be notified of the final permit determination made by the Director of EPD. EPD will announce any substantial changes in the final determination by public notice. All comments received on or before **August 24, 2026**, will be considered when the final decision to issue or deny the modified permit is made.
