Instructions for providing maps or location information for your application:

Talk with **EPD** (Tifton Office), your NRCS representative or UGA extension agent, well driller, irrigation supplier or other professional to determine appropriate locations for your proposed water source. Then, for the location you plan to install pumps or drill a well, please attach a map or specific details to locate your planned withdrawal to your application. On the same map or an additional map, mark the outline of the acres you intend to irrigate. Here are some options to prepare maps or information to send:

- a. If you have a GPS unit, go to the site, record the latitude and longitude. **Be sure to record all digits shown to get within a hundred feet or so.** Enter this information in the latitude/longitude sections on your application. You can also call or email us with this information.
- b. Some online maps, like GoogleMaps have the option of viewing and printing hybrid maps maps with roads over top of an aerial or satellite image. For Google Maps, <u>http://maps.google.com</u> type in your street address or city to zoom in, and then select hybrid in the upper right corner. Locate your withdrawal point, print the map, clearly marking the paper copy, and mail it to us with your application. Be sure that it includes enough landmarks to figure out where in the county that it is located, or also attach a separate countywide map showing approximate location.
- c. USGS topographic, NRSC, or FSA maps show streams, ponds, and fields. Copy a section that includes your withdrawal location. Mark your location and mail it in with your application. Be sure that it includes enough landmarks to figure out where in the county that it is located, or also attach a separate countywide map showing approximate location.

What follow-up can I expect from this application?

EPD's Agricultural Permitting Unit, located in Tifton, Georgia, will send you a **confirmation letter** that your application is complete or request missing information. We cannot process incomplete applications. PLEASE call us if you have any **questions about how to complete the application, and we will be happy to assist you.** When the application is complete, your application information is entered into our records and the location is mapped into a geographic information system (GIS). Applications are then given a thorough **geologic and/or hydrologic evaluations** based upon your request.

Evaluations are performed in order of date received. The evaluations seek to protect existing users to the extent provided in Georgia law, and they determine potential impact on natural resources. The evaluations are performed in light of any current water restrictions that may be authorized by the General Assembly, the DNR Board, or other appropriate agencies. If your request is in conflict with any current restrictions, you will be notified and your options explained. In some cases, your request may be too close to another user or may seek access to waters that are already at capacity use. We will inform you of these issues and explain your options.

If no problems are found during the evaluation, we will issue a **Letter of Concurrence**. This is your permission to proceed with financing, design, and installation of the water source. It is at this time that you can hire a well driller, who can drill, develop, and test your well, and or install a surface water pump. You may also proceed with installation of irrigation systems. There is a one-year period for you to complete your installation and return the required forms to EPD.

One of the conditions of your Letter of Concurrence will be that you notify EPD by the expiration date of the Letter of Concurrence if you do not install the withdrawal sources you requested.

Your Georgia licensed water well contractor must complete the *Well Completion Data Form and Log.* YOU must then forward ALL NECESSARY paperwork, including the Flow Meter Approval Form, the Well Completion Form & Log, and additional Irrigation Conservation Plans and/or Low Flow Protection Plans as requested by EPD in your Letter of Concurrence.

Once forms are received, reviewed, and approved by EPD, we will recommend that your Permit to Withdraw Water for Agricultural purposes be issued by the Director of EPD. For groundwater and/or surface water agricultural water use withdrawals, you cannot use more than 100,000 gallons of water per day (on a monthly average) until the permit is issued.
