Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will consist of constructing a *new* beach (\pm 305 linear feet) along Chief McIntosh Lake and as per the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a concrete access ramp from the proposed parking area. The *abandoned* beach (\pm 320 linear feet) located along Chief McIntosh Lake will be re-vegetated and stabilized with native riparian seed mix and volunteer woody plants. Construction activities will result buffer impacts (\pm 625 linear feet total, \pm 15,430 square feet total) along Chief McIntosh Lake, a tributary to Big Sandy Creek in the *Upper Ocmulgee Watershed*, in Indian Spring State Park in Butts County.
