Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2) (a-k)}: (a, h)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project would impact Intermittent Streams</u> (IS) 11 and IS 13 to include Perennial Stream (PS) 12 for the widening of State Route (SR) 3/United States Highway (US) 19/US from south of County Road (CR) 504/Tara Road to south of SR 54 in Clayton County, Georgia. This project will change the existing four-lane roadway to a six-lane roadway with a 32-foot-wide grassed median. The project would impact the 25-foot state mandated buffer under criterion 2(a, and h) within the Upper Flint watershed. The proposed project begins approximately 3.52 miles south of I-75 and extends south to the project center on Tara Boulevard.
