This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an Application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2) (a-k)}: (a, b, h)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity: **The proposed project would impact Intermittent Stream (IS) 4c, IS 5, IS 7, Perennial Stream (PS) 4, PS 6, and Open Water (OW) 3 for the widening of State Route (SR) 92/Lake Acworth Drive to a divided four-lane roadway with a raised concrete median ranging from 2 to 18 feet in width. A bridge is being replaced over Lake Acworth along with two new bridges being constructed over Main Street and the Western & Atlantic/CSX RR, and Tanyard Creek. The project would impact the 25-foot state mandated buffer of IS 4c (tributary to Lake Allatoona), IS 5, IS 7 (tributaries to PS6/Tanyard Creek), PS 4 (tributary to Lake Allatoona, PS 6/Tanyard Creek, and OW 3/Lake Acworth within the Etowah River watershed. The mid-point of the proposed project is approximately 34.071193 °N and 84.684169 °W.**

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
