Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(A-K)}: ___A

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact 100 linear feet (2,500 ft²) of lake buffer along Lake Redwine to construct a 3 ft. high 1 ft. wide wood timber retaining wall to control ongoing erosion and protect private property. The recently constructed community dock lies near this property and wave action from recreational boaters is impacting the shoreline. A 10 ft. walkway will also be installed to provide access to the 16 ft. dock platform. The applicant will revegetate the buffer with multi-trophic vegetation as shown on the revegetation plan in accordance with EPD's Streambank and Shoreline Stabilization Guidance Document. The property is located on Waterview Ct. on Lot 38.
