Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (b)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Stormwater runoff has caused flooding and erosion along an unnamed stream, a tributary to North Fork Peachtree Creek, along Dresden Drive and Brookline Circle in Brookhaven. The proposed project will consist of reconnecting the streambank with the floodplain, grading the streambank to a more stable slope (3H:1V) and soil bioengineering systems and integrated bioengineering practices (including live staking, coir logs and joint planting with native riparian seed mix, *Silky Dogwood*, *Black Willow* and/or *Buttonbush* live stake cuttings and matting blankets). This project will result in ±665 linear feet total (±16,260 square feet total) of buffer impacts along an unnamed stream, a tributary to North Fork Peachtree Creek in the *Upper Chattahoochee Watershed*.
