Activity

This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed stormwater maintenance project will consist of dredging Lake Alexander and the *existing* sediment basin (i.e, forebay) and re-grading the *existing* sediment basin (3H:1V). The dredged sediment will be dried and hauled to a Land Application System (LAS) facility in Covington and the buffers will be restored to existing conditions to the extent practicable. Land disturbing activities will result in buffer impacts (± 1,633 linear feet total, ± 35,972 square feet total) along Lake Alexander and the forebay located along an unnamed perennial stream, a tributary to the Alcovy River in the *Upper Ocmulgee Watershed*.
