Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(A-K)}: A

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact a total of 176 linear feet (5,985 ft2) of stream buffer along an unnamed tributary of Raccoon Creek to replace the bridge over Raccoon Creek. Non-exempt buffer impacts include cut and fill along the northeast side of Raccoon Creek Rd. The buffer impacts and road re-alignment are necessary for the new bridge alignment. The buffer will be re-vegetated with native riparian grass seed as per GDOT Standard Specification 700. The project is located on S. High Shoals Rd. approximately 8.5 mi. from the intersection of GA-61 and High Shoals Rd.
