Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to decommission and demolish Plant Branch. Disturbance activities within the buffers include removal of stockpile materials, restoring excavated areas to original grade and buffer revegetation. The proposed project will result in buffer impacts to 150 linear feet total (528 square feet total) to two unnamed tributaries to Lake Sinclair in the *Upper Oconee Watershed*.
