Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(A-K)}: A

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact 375 linear ft. (4,275 ft²) of stream buffer in three separate areas along Cow Branch where three stormwater outfalls are disconnected from their upstream structures by approximately 8 vertical ft. Impacts include 1,596 ft² for placement of rip rap and 2,679 ft² for grading to re-connect the outfall structures and associated energy dissipation structures. The project is located within Fort Gordon approximately 1,000 ft. downstream from the Fort Gordon Base Commissary.
