
Dear Participant/Commenter:

<p><b><u>Monitoring Requirement</u></b></p> <p>The facility has requested to keep the Total Suspended Solids (TSS) sample type as grab sample as in current permit.</p>	<p>The permit has been revised to modify the sample type to grab for TSS.</p>
<p><b><u>Reporting</u></b></p> <p>The facility has requested to maintain quarterly reporting schedule as in current permit.</p>	<p>The permit has been revised to modify the reporting frequency to quarterly. The monitoring frequency will be evaluated during the next permit cycle.</p>
<p><b><u>Annual Certification</u></b></p> <p>The facility has requested to change their annual certification to July of each year for consistency with their Rocky Mountain Permit.</p>	<p>The annual certification date will not change because this is a standard boilerplate condition and is currently consistent for all permittees.</p>
