
Dear Ms. Fox:

**Public Comments and EPD Responses on Draft Pretreatment Permit
D&B Custom Powder Coating & Hydrographics, Inc. – Permit No. GAP050298**

COMMENTS RECEIVED	EPD RESPONSE
<p>As you probably recall, D&B Powder is a very small facility owned by a couple in Trenton GA. They produce only a small volume of discharge with previous monitoring data indicating that pollutant levels are low or non-detectable.</p> <p>We are concerned that the monthly monitoring requirement for TTOs will be cost-prohibitive for the business. We request that this requirement be changed in the draft permit to only once or twice per year. This seems reasonable given these pollutants were not an issue in previous monitoring data that has already been submitted to EPD.</p>	<p>EPD has evaluated your request and reviewed the data submitted with the application. The request to modify the sampling frequency is reasonable and EPD concurs with the request. The sampling frequency for TTOs has been modified to be once every six months.</p>
