I. NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT TO DISCHARGE TREATED WASTEWATER INTO WATERS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA

NPDES permits are valid for a maximum of five years. Prior to expiration of an existing permit, a new application must be submitted and evaluated.

An antidegradation analysis is conducted, as applicable, for new or expanded point source discharges that are proposed. The analysis evaluates whether allowing lower water quality is necessary to accommodate important economic or social development in the area in which the waters are located. In all cases, existing instream water uses and the level of water quality necessary to protect the existing use is maintained and protected.

All municipalities must be in compliance with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Service Delivery Strategy in order to receive a permit.

Having reviewed such applications, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is considering the issuance of NPDES permits to the following applicants, subject to specific pollutant limitations and special conditions.

NPDES PERMIT REISSUANCE

Chatham County

PCS Nitrogen Fertilizer, L.P. 1460 Columbia Nitrogen Road Augusta, Georgia 30901 NPDES Permit No. GA0002356, for it former nitrogen fertilizer manufacturing facility located in Port Wentworth, Chatham County, Georgia. The facility discharges a maximum of 0.21 MGD of stormwater and wastewater associated with prior operations to Savannah Harbor in the Savannah River Basin.

Glynn County

Brunswick Cellulose LLC, 1400 West 9th Street, Brunswick, Georgia 31520, NPDES Permit No. GA0003654, for its pulp and paper mill located at 1400 West 9th Street, Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia. An average of 27 MGD of Pulp Mill process wastewater from brownstock/O₂ delignification, bleach plant, chlorine dioxide generators, pre-evaporators, concentrators, recovery boilers, bark & power boiler, de-mineralizers, cooling towers, kiln, pulp dryers, sanitary lift pumps, maintenance wastewater, and storm water is discharged to the Turtle River in the Satilla River Basin.

NPDES PERMIT TERMINATION

Washington County

Kentucky-Tennessee Clay Company, 3597 Deepstep Road, Sandersville, Georgia 31082, NPDES Permit No. GA0035611, for the Siloam Quarry located on Siloam-Veazy Road in Siloam, Washington County. The facility has requested to terminate NPDES Permit No. GA0035611 and get coverage under the General Mining and Processing Permit No. GAG300041.

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II. NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR AN INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT PERMITS TO DISCHARGE WASTEWATER TO A PUBLICLY OWNED TREATMENT WORKS.

Industrial Pretreatment permits are valid for a maximum of five years. Prior to expiration of an existing permit, a new application must be submitted and evaluated.

INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT PERMIT REISSUANCE

Oconee County

AmeriPride Uniform and Linen, P.O. Box 185, Watkinsville, Georgia 30677, Permit No. GAP050114, for its laundry facility located at 1081 Experiment Station Road, Watkinsville, Georgia 30677. A maximum of 0.15 MGD of pretreated wastewater is discharged to the Oconee County Calls Creek Water Reclamation Facility in the Oconee River Basin.

III. NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A LAND APPLICATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR THE DISPOSAL OF WASTEWATER APPLIED TO THE SURFACE OR BENEATH THE SURFACE OF LAND.

Land Application System (LAS) permits are valid for a maximum of five years. Prior to expiration of an existing permit, a new application must be submitted and evaluated.

All municipalities must be in compliance with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Service Delivery Strategy in order to receive a permit.

Serenbe Town Association, 9110 Selborne Lane, Suite 210, Chattahoochee Hills, Georgia, 30268, LAS Permit No. GAJ030725, for the Serenbe Water Pollution Control Plant, located at Selborne Lane, Chattahoochee Hills, Georgia, 30268. Approximately 0.031 MGD of treated wastewater is land applied to a dedicated site in Fulton County in the Chattahoochee River Basin. The permit has also been modified to include effluent limitations and monitoring requirements for the phased expansion of the facility.
