Comment	EPD Response
Due to the fact that the system sprays for roughly 2.5 hours each time they apply composite sampling would render more pond content than treated effluent. We are asking EPD to change this to grab sampling.	EPD has changed the sampling requirement for Five-Day Biochemical Oxygen Demand and Total Suspended Solids from composite to grab samples.
