# **REVISED TOTAL COLIFORM RULE (RTCR) ADDENDUM**

### Level 1 Assessment Triggers

- A water system collecting fewer than 40 samples per month has two (2) or more total coliform positive routine/repeat samples in the same month.
- A water system collecting at least 40 samples per month has greater than 5.0% of the routine/repeat samples in the same month that are total coliform positive.
- A water system fails to take every required repeat sample after any single total coliform positive sample.

#### E. coli MCL Violation occurs with any of the following sample result combinations:

- If a Routine sample is E. coli positive and any of the corresponding repeat samples are total coliform positive.
- If a Routine sample is E. coli positive and any of the three (3) corresponding repeat samples are not collected.
- If a Routine sample is E. coli positive and any of the corresponding repeat samples are E. coli positive.
- If a Routine sample is total coliform positive and any of the corresponding repeat samples are E. coli positive.
- If a Routine sample is total coliform positive and any of the corresponding repeat samples are total coliform positive AND the sample was not analyzed for E. coli.

## In the event of an E. coli MCL violation:

- Notify the public with a Tier 1 Public Notice **boil water notice** that either is written or by another approved method (radio, TV, hand delivery, posted) within 24 hours.
- Collect special sample(s) as soon as possible to verify results.

#### Level 2 Assessment Triggers

- A water system incurs an E. coli MCL violation.
- A water system has a second Level 1 Assessment within a rolling 12-month period.
