Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 50-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05(2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity: The proposed project would impact buffers to Perennial Stream 2/ Crooked Creek (Brasstown Creek) for the bridge replacement of State Route 66. The project would impact the 50-foot state mandated buffer of unnamed tributaries to Crooked Creek within the Hiwassee watershed. Non-exempt Disturbance activities would consist of placement of fill (rip-rap) to stabilize existing scour and eroded streambank. BMPs such as orange barrier fence and rip-rap will be placed within the buffer. The proposed project begins 1,400 feet south and ends approximately 1,000 feet north of the existing bridge on SR 399/ Crooked Creek Road.
