The</u> <u>project would impact the 25-foot state mandated buffer of unnamed tributaries to Tesnatee Creek within</u> <u>the Upper Chattahoochee watershed. The proposed project begins at the intersection of CR68/Hulsey</u> <u>Road and U.S. Highway (US) 129/State Route (SR) 11 and continues east along the current alignment of</u> <u>CR 68/Hulsey Road, ending at the intersection of CR 68/Hulsey Road and SR 75.</u>
