- Georgia residents interested in learning about how EPA’s Climate Pollution Reduction Grant can help Georgia develop strategies for reducing emissions and increasing economic development.

Description: Join the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Air Protection Branch to learn about our next deliverable for EPA’s Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG) and the Peach State Voluntary Emission Reduction Plan.

As part of the Inflation Reduction Act, the Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG) program provided \$5 billion in grants to states, local governments, tribes, and territories to develop and implement plans to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and other harmful air pollution. This two-staged grant program provides funding of \$250 million for noncompetitive planning grants (\$3M to each lead agency to develop a Climate Pollution Reduction Plan), and \$4.6 billion for competitive implementation grants. On September 21, EPA announced Phase 2 of the CPRG program, which includes two competitions totaling \$4.6 billion: a general competition for applications from states, municipalities, tribes, tribal consortia, and territories, and a competition only for tribes, tribal consortia, and territories.
