

## **EPD Stakeholder Meeting Land Protection Branch Discussion of Rule Changes**

The purpose of this meeting is to inform and solicit input from the public and impacted organizations regarding the development of amendments to the Rules for Solid Waste Management (391-3-4) related to Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR).

EPD's primary goals and objectives are to ensure that stakeholders are given the opportunity to understand the process of rule revisions and the scope of the rule changes that are under consideration. EPD will also listen to comments and address stakeholder questions.
