

**PUBLIC NOTICE
NOTICE OF INTENT TO MODIFY PERMIT**

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, under the authority of the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-8-60, et. seq., as amended, announces its intent to modify Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. HW-016(ST&CA) issued to Fibrant LLC (formerly known as DSM Chemicals North America, Inc.). The permitted facility is located in Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia and is operated by Fibrant LLC (Fibrant). The permit modification will revise the boundaries of the Fibrant RCRA Facility Map by removing non-manufacturing parcels including undeveloped property and an office building parcel.

A revised Facility drawing has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-11.

Before making its final decision on whether to grant or deny the permit modification request, state and federal regulations require that the EPD provide an opportunity for public comment.
