

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the First Voluntary Investigation and Remediation Plan (VIRP) Semi-Annual Progress Report (Report) submitted by Lafarge Road Marking, Inc. (LRM) pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act). EPD has also reviewed the Progress Report received April 11, 2014 and the Groundwater Monitoring Report, received July 30, 2014. EPD commends LRM for the proactive and substantial remediation efforts being undertaken at the site. Removal results from the new remediation systems are particularly impressive.

Risk Reduction Standards (RRS) presented in the Report are approved by EPD. Based on the Report and additional documentation submitted by ARCADIS via email on August 28, 2015, EPD concurs that delineation of lead in soils has been completed to Type 2 RRS. Please include all delineation documentation, sampling results, and laboratory reports in the forthcoming Report.

EPD appreciates that LRM specifically addressed each comment from EPD's March 14, 2014 letter in LRM's April 30, 2014 response letter. EPD has noted LRM's intentions to address other comments from EPD's March 14, 2014 letter as well. Please continue to address these and future comments in subsequent semi-annual progress reports.
