

**PUBLIC NOTICE
NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT**

The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, under the authority of the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act, O.C.G.A. Section 12-8-60, et. seq., as amended, announces its intent to renew Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. HW-071(S) issued to Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. The permitted facility is located in Macon, Bibb County, Georgia and is owned and operated by Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. If renewed, the permit will continue to allow the permittee to store hazardous waste in containers and a 10,000 gallon tank. The permit will require the investigation and corrective action of any discovered releases of hazardous constituents into the environment from present or past operations at the facility.

This Safety-Kleen facility is an accumulation point for spent solvents, dry cleaning waste, paint gun cleaners and filters which are generated by customers. All wastes are ultimately shipped to another Safety-Kleen recycling facility or contract reclaimer and much of the solvents are then returned to the facility's customers as product. If the renewal permit is approved, Safety-Kleen will continue to operate the following hazardous waste management units: one (1) 10,000 gallon aboveground tank inside a concrete dike, which is used to store spent solvent, and two (2) hazardous waste container storage units with a total capacity of 4,580 gallons.

A draft permit has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-11, which contains the conditions for storing hazardous waste in containers and a tank at the facility and the investigation and corrective action of any discovered releases of hazardous constituents into the environment from operations at the facility. The draft permit does not allow for disposal of hazardous waste on-site.

Before making its final decision on whether to issue the renewal permit, state and federal regulations require that the EPD provide an opportunity for public comment. Accordingly, a public comment period has been arranged for June 13, 2017 through July 31, 2017. During the public comment period, a copy of the draft renewal permit and supporting documents will be available for public review at the following locations during regular business hours:

EPD will schedule a public hearing on the draft renewal permit if a request for one is received by the Director before the close of the public comment period.
