The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has evaluated the supplemental notification dated September 25, 2012 for the above-referenced property to determine whether a release exceeding a reportable quantity has occurred. The supplemental notification contains no new information that would alter the previous scoring for this property that occurred in 2009 (previously known as Constantine Dyeing). As a result of the 2009 evaluation, this property was not listed on the Hazardous Site Inventory (HSI).

The property was evaluated as having unlimited access, non-residential use, with the nearest drinking water well located between 2 and 3 miles from the site. Enclosed is a copy of our Reportable Quantities Screening Method (RQSM) score sheet that summarizes the conditions used to evaluate this property in 2009.


