### CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION DETERMINATION

Collection System and Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements  
in Cedartown, Georgia  
CW2018-007

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has conducted a review of the above project in accordance with the State's Environmental Review Process (SERP) for Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) projects. EPD has determined that this project is eligible for a categorical exclusion. Accordingly, no further environmental review is planned. The proposed project will include replacement of the existing Cedartown wastewater treatment plant influent lift station and Cave Springs Road sewer lift station. The project will also include replacement of the rotary influent screens at the Cedartown wastewater treatment plant and slip lining approximately 1,800 LF of 10" gravity sewer lines from Cave Springs Road sewer lift station to College Street.

This project is eligible for a categorical exclusion because it meets the following specific criteria, outlined in the CWSRF SERP: minor rehabilitation of existing facilities, functional replacement of equipment and construction of new ancillary facilities adjacent to existing facilities that do not affect the degree of treatment or capacity of the existing facility. Furthermore: the project will not create a new or relocate an existing discharge to surface or ground waters; the project will not substantially increase the volume of discharge or loading of pollutants; the project will not provide capacity to serve a population 30% greater than the existing population; the project will not have a significant effect on the quality of the human environment; the action will not directly or indirectly affect cultural resources, habitats of endangered or threatened species, or environmentally important natural resource areas; and the action is cost-effective and should cause no significant public controversy.


This determination becomes effective after thirty (30) days following its distribution by EPD. This exclusion may be revoked at any time if: 1) the project is altered and no longer meets the requirements of a categorical exclusion, 2) new evidence shows that serious environmental issues exist, or 3) a local, State or Federal law is being or may be violated. The information which supports this decision is on file with the Georgia Environmental Protection Division and is available for public scrutiny upon request. A copy of the proposed project documentation is also available for review at the Cedartown City Hall.

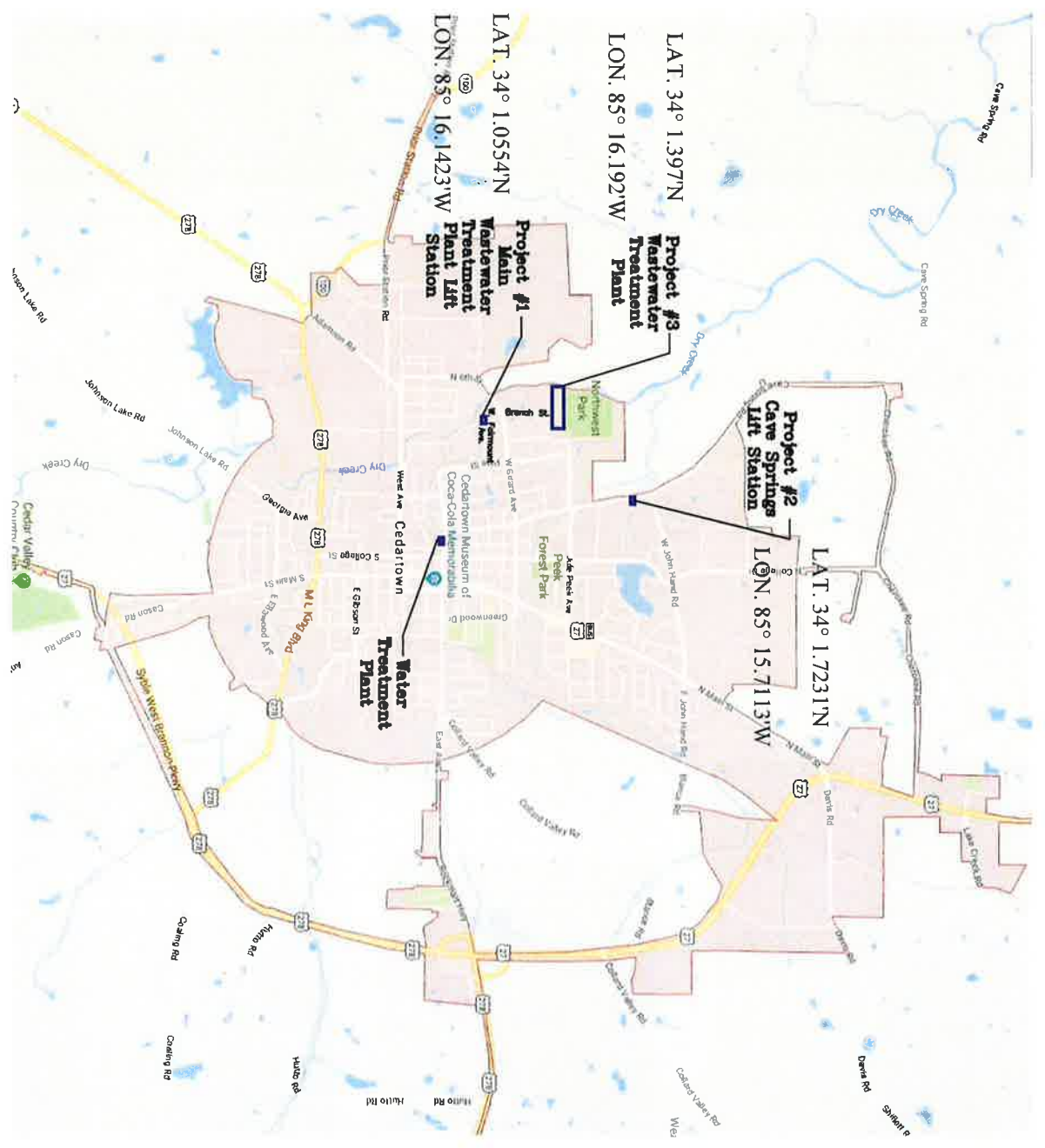

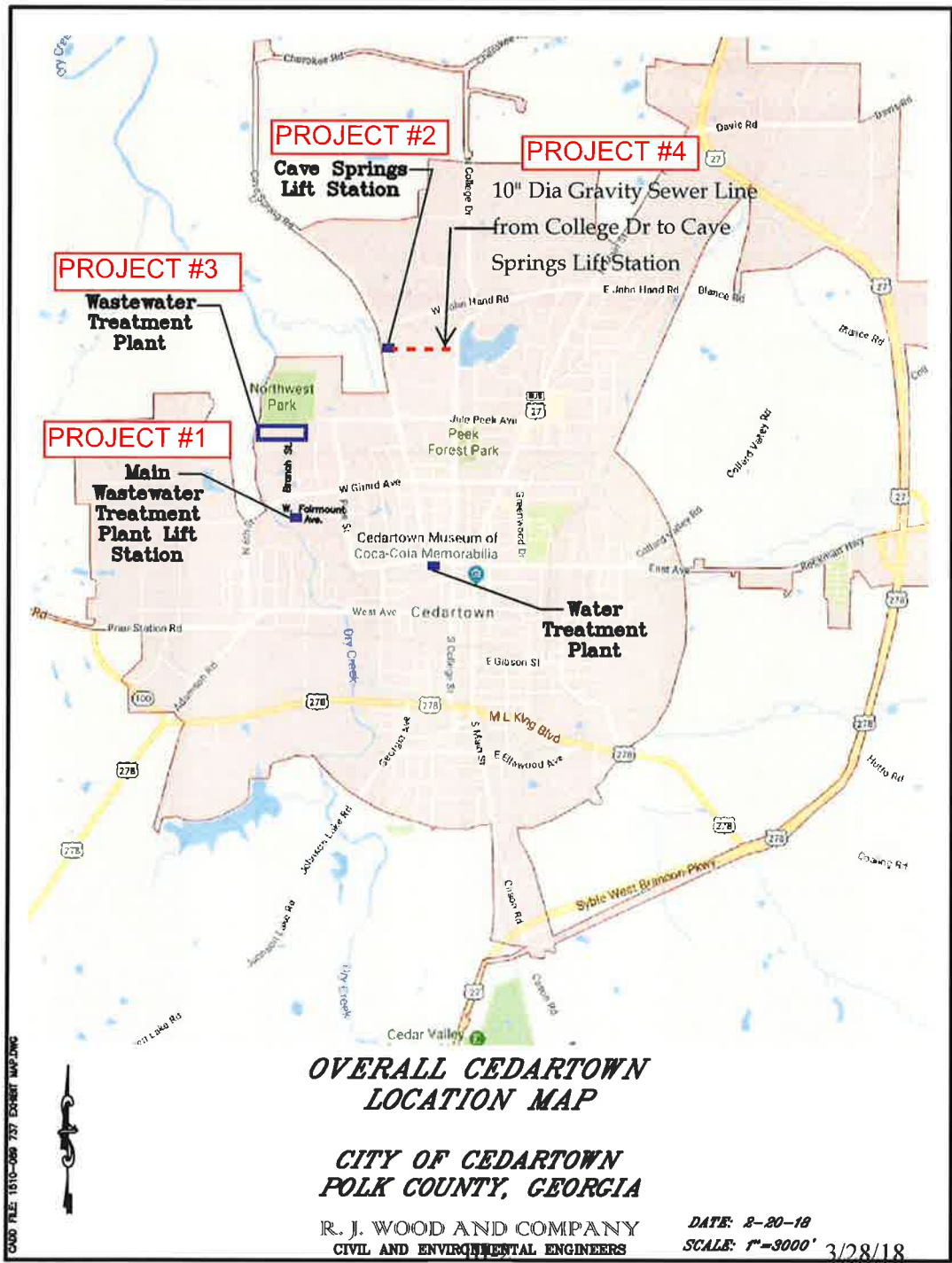
