Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The project involves buffer encroachments necessary to construct 93 linear feet of a concrete retaining wall to address an existing erosion problem along Lake Arrowhead. Mitigation requirements have been met in accordance with the Streambank and Shoreline Stabilization Guidance. The project site is located at 5015 Peninsula Drive in Cherokee County and will result in 93 linear feet of buffer impacts along the shoreline of Lake Arrowhead.

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
