Subject: Clarification of Georgia Permitted Landfills for Asbestos Disposal

The Georgia Rules for Solid Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-4-.04(8) provides for the disposal of asbestos containing solid wastes into permitted landfills. Two permit classifications of landfills are available for the disposal of such wastes, including Municipal Solid Waste Landfills and Construction and Demolition Landfills.

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has lists available to assist you with the locations of each of these type of facilities. These lists are named the following:

## **List of Georgia Permitted Construction and Demolition Landfills**
